Rules & Regulations

1. The Florida Department of Agriculture will have an inspector at the fair on the day of admission of birds for exhibition in order to check certificates of purchase and to blood test those birds which do not have such certificates accompanying them.
2. ENTRIES: All entries must be made out on entry forms. All entries must arrive at the fairgrounds on Saturday, October 2, 2010 – 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m..
3. The superintendent will see that the exhibits are placed in display coops and turned over to the owner at the completion of the show.
4. The superintendent reserves the right to refuse the entry of any poultry which shows signs of disease or are infested with lice, mites or fleas.
5. All poultry must be owned and cared for by the exhibitor 30 days before the fair.
6. Exhibitors will be exhibiting their own birds and will do so at their own risk.
7. JUDGING: The modified Danish system of judging will be used. The decision of the judge(s) is final.
- 8 Exhibitors or exhibitors parents may not be present during judging.
9. Any one exhibitor may enter no more than ten (10) poultry entries if space available. Cloverbuds may exhibit no more than five (5) poultry entries. Cloverbuds exhibit for participation only.
10. ELIGIBILITY: Open to any 4-H Club or FFA member carrying a bona fide poultry project.
11. Poultry may be entered in the following classes:
 - PRODUCTION CLASS**– Entries limited to production type Leghorns, Rhode Island Reds, Barred and Whit Plymouth Rocks, and recognized production cross breeds. No sex-link males may be shown.
 - EXHIBITION CLASS**– Entries limited to purebred large fowl and bantams recognized by the American Poultry Association.
 - MISCELLANEOUS CLASS**– Entries limited to the following: turkeys, quail, pigeons, doves, guineas, peafowl, and pheasants.
 - WATERFOWL CLASS**– Entries limited to purebred ducks and geese.
12. Exhibitors must furnish their own cages for quail, pigeons, and doves. Cages not to exceed 16 inches in height, width or depth.
13. No chickens from out of state.
14. Entries will be fed and watered by the fair and the feed and water containers will be provided by the fair.
15. Entries will not be released until after 10:00 PM Saturday, October 9, 2010. Any bird removed from the show prior to this time without consent of the show superintendent and the fair officials will forfeit all awards.
