

# **YOUTH RABBIT SHOW – Saturday, October 2, 2010 7:00 P.M.**

OPEN TO ALL 4-H & FFA MEMBERS**

1. Entries restricted to bona fide 4-H & FFA members. Entry form must be signed by leader or advisor.
2. Cloverbuds may exhibit Rabbits and Poultry for participation. Competition begins when a 4-H'er is 8 years old before September 1<sup>st</sup> of the fair year.
3. Rabbits must have been owned and cared by member at least 30 days prior to fair.
4. Rabbits must be pre-registered. Deadline for registering is September 3, 2010.
5. All rabbits must be tattooed before entering fair.
6. Enter rabbits on Saturday, October 2, 2010 between 10:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.
7. Entries will be fed and watered by exhibitors throughout the fair; exhibitors must provide feed and water containers.
8. Limit five per exhibitor – 10 is space available.
9. Entries must be picked up after 10:00 p.m. Saturday, October 9, 2010.
10. JUDGING: The modified Danish system of judging will be used.
11. The Baker County Fair Association is not responsible for any damage or loss of animals or equipment.
12. All rabbits must be pure-bred. All mixed breed rabbits will be disqualified except for the meat pen class (see below).
13. A Meat Pen (fryer) entry to be comprised of (3) animals kindled six to ten (10) weeks before the fair by the exhibitors own project does. The meat pen animals need not be from the same litter, but should be as much alike as possible and weigh between 4-5 pounds live weight. Crossbred or purebreds are acceptable for this class.
