**Mandatory Final Weigh-In: Sunday, October 2, 2011, 2:00 PM– 6:00 PM**

**Exhibitors/Parents Meeting: Sunday, October 23, 2011 8:00 PM**

**Record Book Deadline: Monday, October 3, 2011, 7:00 PM**

1. All steers must be weighed and tagged on Saturday, July 2, 2010, 8:00 AM – 10:00 aM, at the Baker County fairgrounds.
2. Any steer weighing less than 850 lbs. will be disqualified at the final weigh-in on Sunday, October 2, 2011.
3. Steers will be received for the fair on Sunday, October 2, 2011, 2:00 PM - 6:00 PM. The final weigh-in will be on Sunday, October 2, 2011, 2:00 PM – 6:00 PM.
4. Exhibitors, including individual, club, or group, must have owned and cared for their steer from Saturday, July 2, 2011.
5. Exhibitors, including individual, club, or group, are limited to one (1) steer.
6. All exhibitors must be a resident of Baker County.
7. All exhibitors will comply with the health regulations listed in the fair book page, entitled "Animal Health Rules" and the general rules page, entitled, "Agricultural Division".
8. Every exhibitor must sign a statement that any drug, antibiotic, wormer or biological substance which may have been administered by myself or any other person was done so in strict compliance with the manufacturer's label requirements.
9. All steers must be at 100% beef breeding.
10. Steers will be shown in respective classes broken down by weight.
11. A fee of \$25, plus 3% of the sale price of the steer, will be charged by the Baker County Fair Association. This will help with the expenses of trophies, plaques, ribbons, pictures, and buyer thank you ad in the newspaper.
12. Showmanship and Fitting and Grooming will be judged before the actual steer show starts.
13. All exhibitors must turn in an up-to-date record book at the fairgrounds on Monday, October 3, 2011, 7:00 PM. Record books will be given out at the beginning of the steer program. Workshop clinic date and time will be announced by the Coordinator. Record book prizes are as follows: First place winner will be a plaque and \$25. Second place winner will be a rosette and \$15. There will be two divisions: 4-H and FFA.
14. No water will be left in the beds by exhibitors. All pans and buckets will be picked up daily.
15. All steers will be halter-broken and each exhibitor should be able to handle his/her steer by Sunday, October 2, 2011.
16. Any 4-H or FFA Chapter /Group owning a steer must assign a sole caretaker for the steer ( ie. Showing, feeding, washing, etc.).
17. If a steer missed a designated weigh-in, because of a behavior problem, there will be a thirty (30) minute grace period. The steer will be reweighed after all other steers are weighed. There will be no other reweighs, except at the request of the livestock chairmen during these designated hours.
18. Halters and neck ropes will be required on all steers.
19. The Baker County Fair Association makes no guarantees, expressed or implied, as to the quality of any steer.
20. Weight Gain Contest - Prizes will be given to the top three (3) steers gaining the most weight during the contest. First place prize will be a plaque and \$25. Second place prize will be a rosette and \$15. Third place prize will be rosette and \$10. This contest will begin with the initial weigh-in on Sunday, June 25, 2011, and end with the final weigh-in on Sunday, October 2, 2011.
21. In order to qualify for the show, sale, and weight gain contest all steers must weigh between 850 lbs. and 1400 lbs. at the final weigh-in.
22. All steers entered in the weight gain contest will be entered in the show on Tuesday, October 4, 2011, and sale on Thursday, October 6, 2011.
23. Maximum steer sale weight for payment will be 1350 lbs. Steers weighing more than 1350 lbs. will be sold at 1350 lbs.

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24. A trophy and belt buckle will be provided to the Grand and Reserve Champion steer exhibitors.

25. There will be a home grown steer division at the conclusion of the regular steer show. No premiums will be paid as home grown steers must also compete in the regular steer show for premiums. Ribbons and trophies will be provided.
